- Hold a degree (BS) in System Engineering or similar discipline. Project Management Professional certification also desired.
- Comfortable leading a team of professionals within the business, application/systems, data/information and technical architecture disciplines. Must have excellent communication skills to be able to clearly explain the benefits of an architectural approach to clients and stakeholders.
- Have broad and diverse background in such areas as: business analysis, applications/systems engineering, and information operations/architectures.
